Legislative Goals for 111th Congress The Arc, UCP, AAIDD, AUCD, NACDD ANCOR Disability Policy Collaboration:

 Enhance adult education, vocational training, post-secondary education and lifelong learning opportunities for students with disabilities, particularly students with intellectual and/or multiple impairments.

The Arc & AAIDD Position Statement on Education:

- Provide access to regular curricula and extracurricular services and experiences with peers of the same age without disabilities, including access to post-secondary education.
- Include transition into employment or further post-secondary education.

• The role of the Supports Intensity Scale in promoting the transition from secondary to post-secondary education and in identifying support needs for use by students with intellectual and developmental disabilities to succeed in post-secondary settings.
